The Emergency Management Office, Office of the Governor, would like to inform the general public that at **3:46 P.m. this AFTERNOON, Friday, March 11, 2011**, there was an earthquake with preliminary magnitude of **7.9** on Richter scale located at latitude **38.0** degrees North **142.9** degrees East, East of Honshu, Japan region.
